

# Graduation Requirements

The College has established minimum competencies that must be attained in each program. Students will be awarded upon completion of academic requirements and demonstration of the required competencies.

To be eligible for graduation, students must:

- Satisfactorily complete all requirements in their academic program
- Earn a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher
- Meet all obligations to the College, including payment of all tuition and fees
- Submit an Intent to Graduate form with the Registrar's Office.

The student has the primary responsibility for ensuring that he/she meets degree and certificate requirements for graduation. The student should initiate at least one meeting with his/her faculty advisor each semester to ensure all the graduation requirements have or will be met by the intended time of graduation. The Registrar of the College is responsible for the final audit before the student is awarded a degree or certificate. Students receiving a certificate do not participate in the commencement ceremony.
